

FEES 2024-2025 ACADEMIC YEAR

Pre-registration Fee:

There is a 300€ pre-registration fee for all new admission applications, with the following guidelines:

- If the student is admitted, the pre-registration fee will be deducted from the Registration Fee.
- If the student is admitted, but the applicant rejects the enrollment, the pre-registration Fee will become nonrefundable.
- If the student is not admitted, the pre-registration is refunded in the month of February or upon completion of the enrollment.

This fee will be effective once all the enrollment documentation is received, duly filled in.

Registration Fee – Social Fund Contribution:

Parents of students who register for the first time in the school, must pay the following Entrance Fee as a new member of the Association (Social Fund Contribution):

- 3.350 € per student who enrolls in grades from Preschool to 5th grade (PYP 5)
- 4.500 € per student who enrolls in grades from 6th grade (MYP 1) to 10th grade (MYP 5)
- 6.000 € per student who enrolls in grades from 11th grade to 12th grade (IBDP 1 and IBDP 2)

For the third child enrolled simultaneously in the school, there is a 15% discount and a 20% discount for the fourth and 25% discount for the fifth child and successive children always when belonging to the same family unit. The Entrance Fee consists of two separate payments, nonrefundable: The first payment of 1.500 € in April, followed by another one in May amounting to the difference between the total amount and the amount already paid, including the pre-registration fee, if applicable. In the case of the Preschool grade, the fee will be charged at the end of that school year and before beginning the next school year.

Tuition Fees

The annual tuition fees are as follows:

Tuition Fee discounts

If the family has three children enrolled simultaneously in the school, there will be a 20% discount in the tuition of the third child. If a family has four or more children enrolled simultaneously in the school, there will be a 25% discount in the tuition fee of the fourth child and of any additional children.

Supplies Fees

258 € will be charged for books and supplies in the month of September.

An additional amount of 31 € in Preschool and 11 € in the rest of Kinder is applied for water clothing and sleeping bag replacement, at the beginning of the school year.

Bus Service

The bus service fees are as follows:

The bus and lunch services are optional.

Student Support Services Fees (including additional language classes):

- Support Fees (Type 3 of "Student's Support Services Policy"):
 - 1 weekly period 71 € / month
 - 2 weekly periods 142 € / month
 - 3 weekly periods 213 € / month
- Extra language Fee (applicable to students whose language level requires additional support: -2 weekly periods- 1.780 € / year

Method of Payment of Tuition's Fees, Bus Service and Lunch Service:

The aforementioned quantities are annual Fees. Payment can be made as follows:

1. Tuition Fee is an annual fee, and will be charged in ten monthly payments, from September to June inclusive, grade 12 inclusive. Also, Bus and lunch service are annual fees, and will be charged in ten monthly payments, from September to June inclusive.
2. In one single payment. In this case, a 1,25% discount is applied to the annual tuition fee. If this is the chosen option, the decision must be notified to the school before July 15th, through a survey that will be mailed in due time, and the receipt will be billed on the last week of August.

Enrollment Reservation:

During the month of February and March a 500€ enrollment reservation fee will be charged to all enrolled students for the upcoming school year, This fee will be discounted on September's bill as it is a pre-payment. This enrolment reservation fee is subject to the Policy Manual's article 98,11°.
